Articles of Organization
(General Laws, Chapter 180)

Federal Identification Number: 000907907

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:
MY WORLD, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following business activities:

THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CORPORATION IS TO BE FORMED IS FOR SCIENTIFIC, EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501 (C) (3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED, AND IN THIS CONNECTION TO:

1. FUND; DEVELOP CURRICULA FOR; INSTITUTIONALIZE ORGANIZATIONAL PROCEDURES; AND GENERALLY SUPPORT EDUCATIONAL EXPEDITIONS FOR STUDENT GROUPS IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES TO TRAVEL TO UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC, AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION (UNESCO) WORLD HERITAGE SITES AND OTHER AREAS OF ECOLOGICAL OR CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE IN THEIR OWN COUNTRY.
2. PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS COVERING THE COSTS OF SCHOOL FEES, EXAMINATION FEES, AND OTHER EDUCATION-RELATED EXPENSES AT LEAST UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL FOR CERTAIN STUDENTS HAVING ALREADY COMPLETED A MY WORLD EXPEDITION.
3. ORGANIZE CONFERENCES PROMOTING THE EXCHANGE OF IDEAS AND FURTHERING OF EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AMONG GRADUATES OF MY WORLD EXPEDITIONS.
4. DEVELOP OTHER PROGRAMS THAT WILL COMPLEMENT THE ABOVEMENTIONED AIMS OF EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING.
5. INCORPORATE OTHER ORGANIZATIONS, AS NEEDED, TO FACILITATE THE CORPORATION'S PURPOSES.

ALL ACTIONS TAKEN IN PURSUIT OF THESE PURPOSES SHOULD UTILIZE AND RESPECT LOCAL PARTICIPATION, KNOWLEDGE, AND CAPACITY AS FAR AS IS REASONABLY POSSIBLE.

ARTICLE III

A corporation may have one or more classes of members. If it does, the designation of such classes, the manner of election or appointments, the duration of membership and the qualifications and rights, including voting rights, of the members of each class, may be set forth in the by-laws of the corporation or may be set forth below:

THIS CORPORATION SHALL HAVE NO MEMBERS, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS LAW, AND SHALL BE GOVERNED SOLELY BY ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ARTICLE IV

Other lawful provisions, if any, for the conduct and regulation of the business and affairs of the corporation, for its voluntary dissolution, or for limiting, defining, or regulating the powers of the corporation, or of its directors or members, or of any class of members, are as follows: *(If there are no provisions state "NONE")*

A. IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS GRANTED TO THE CORPORATION BY GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 180, THE CORPORATION SHALL HAVE AND MAY EXERCISE IN FURTHERANCE OF ITS CORPORATE PURPOSES EACH OF THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN SECTIONS 9A AND 9B OF MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 156B.

B. NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING ELSE HEREIN PROVIDED, THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED AND SHALL BE OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, CHARITABLE OR LITERARY PURPOSES, AS SAID TERMS HAVE BEEN AND SHALL BE DEFINED PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 170(C) AND 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE. ALL POWERS OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE EXERCISED ONLY IN SUCH MANNER AS WILL ASSURE THE OPERATION OF THIS CORPORATION EXCLUSIVELY FOR SAID RELIGIOUS, EDUCATION, CHARITABLE OR LITERARY PURPOSES, AS SO DEFINED, IT BEING THE INTENTION THAT THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX AND THAT CONTRIBUTIONS TO IT SHALL BE DEDUCTIBLE PURSUANT TO SAID SECTIONS OF THE CODE, AND ALL PURPOSES AND POWERS HEREIN SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND EXERCISED CONSISTENTLY WITH THIS INTENTION.

C. NO PART OF THE NET EARNINGS OF THE CORPORATION SHALL INURE TO THE BENEFIT OF; OR BE DISTRIBUTED TO ITS MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, PRIVATE SHAREHOLDERS OR INDIVIDUALS, EXCEPT THAT THE CORPORATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO PAY REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES ACTUALLY RENDERED AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE CORPORATION'S PURPOSES SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 2 OF THESE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION. NO SUBSTANTIAL PART OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CORPORATION SHALL CONSIST OF THE CARRYING ON OF PROPAGANDA OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTING TO INFLUENCE LEGISLATION (EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 501(H) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE), AND THE CORPORATION SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE OR INTERVENE IN (INCLUDING THE PUBLISHING OR DISTRIBUTION OF STATEMENTS) ANY POLITICAL CAMPAIGN ON BEHALF OF ANY CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OFFICE.

D. EXCEPT AS MAY BE OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY LAW, THE CORPORATION MAY AT ANY TIME AUTHORIZE A PETITION FOR ITS DISSOLUTION TO BE FILED WITH THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF THE DIRECTORS OF THE CORPORATION THEN IN OFFICE; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN THE EVENT OF ANY LIQUIDATION, DISSOLUTION, TERMINATION, OR WINDING UP OF THE CORPORATION (WHETHER VOLUNTARY, INVOLUNTARY OR BY OPERATION OF LAW), THE PROPERTY OR ASSETS OF THE CORPORATION REMAINING AFTER PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ITS DEBTS AND OBLIGATIONS SHALL BE CONVEYED, TRANSFERRED, DISTRIBUTED, AND SET OVER OUTRIGHT TO ONE OR MORE RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, CHARITABLE OR LITERARY INSTITUTIONS OR ORGANIZATIONS, CREATED AND ORGANIZED FOR NON-PROFIT PURPOSES SIMILAR TO THOSE OF THE CORPORATION, WHICH QUALIFY AS EXEMPT FROM INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, AS A MAJORITY OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF THE DIRECTORS OF THE CORPORATION MAY BY VOTE DESIGNATE AND IN SUCH PROPORTIONS AND IN SUCH MANNER AS MAY BE DETERMINED IN SUCH VOTE; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT THE CORPORATION'S PROPERTY MAY BE APPLIED TO CHARITABLE OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DOCTRINE OF CY PRES IN ALL RESPECTS AS A COURT HAVING JURISDICTION MAY DIRECT.

E. NO OFFICER OR DIRECTOR SHALL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE TO THE CORPORATION FOR MONETARY DAMAGES FOR ANY BREACH OF FIDUCIARY DUTY BY SUCH OFFICER OR DIRECTOR AS AN OFFICER OR DIRECTOR NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW IMPOSING SUCH LIABILITY, EXCEPT THAT, TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED BY APPLICABLE LAW, THIS PROVISION SHALL NOT ELIMINATE OR LIMIT THE LIABILITY OF AN OFFICER OR DIRECTOR (I) FOR BREACH OF THE OFFICER'S OR DIRECTOR'S DUTY OF LOYALTY TO THE CORPORATION (II) FOR ACTS OR OMISSIONS NOT IN

GOOD FAITH OR WHICH INVOLVE INTENTIONAL MISCONDUCT OR A KNOWING VIOLATION OF LAW, OR (III) FOR ANY TRANSACTION FROM WHICH THE OFFICER OR DIRECTOR DERIVED AN IMPROPER PERSONAL BENEFIT. NO AMENDMENT OR REPEAL OF THESE PROVISIONS SHALL DEPRIVE AN OFFICER OR DIRECTOR OF THE BENEFITS HEREOF WITH RESPECT TO ANY ACT OR OMISSION OCCURRING PRIOR TO SUCH AMENDMENT OR REPEAL.

Note: The preceding four (4) articles are considered to be permanent and may ONLY be changed by filing appropriate Articles of Amendment.

ARTICLE V

The by-laws of the corporation have been duly adopted and the initial directors, president, treasurer and clerk or other presiding, financial or recording officers, whose names are set out on the following page, have been duly elected.

ARTICLE VI

The effective date of organization of the corporation shall be the date approved and filed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. If a *later* effective date is desired, specify such date which shall not be more than *thirty days* after the date of filing.


